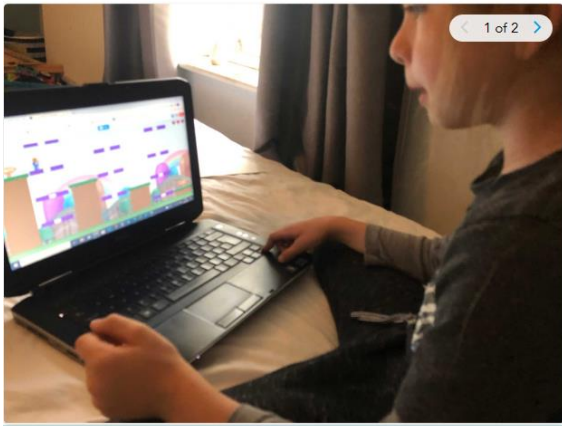
19th July -LEAVERS assembly- all welcome!

21st July- Last day of summer term for full time pupils 2pm finish





