WORLD BOOK DAY

Thursday 7th March is World Book Day. As always, the children can come to school dressed as their favourite book character. Please remember if your child does not feel comfortable dressing up, they don't need to. They can come in their own clothes or uniform- whatever makes them feel comfortable.

As with previous years, please send in any Masked Reader or Extreme Reader entries to school. These are always such a fun way to share their love of reading.

For anyone new to the school-

Masked reader- this is where the children film themselves reading a short excerpt of a book using either a computer generated mask/filter or they can wear a mask or cover up, to hide their identity. They can use funny voices too to help disguise the masked reader. The little ones can 'read' a picture book or retell a well known story they have heard.

Extreme Reader- this is where the children take a picture of themselves reading in an unusual 'extreme' place!

As an extra event this year- to tie in with our Come Read with me Sessions-we are inviting the parents to come in to school from 9-10am, if you are available. We will be having a lovely 'share a book session' with parents in class from 9-9.30 and then you are invited to come to the hall with Mrs Fearnley (as reading lead) and myself for a parent reading workshop from 9.30-10am. Please feel free to attend part or all of the 9-10am session and we will send out any materials shared following the session.
