

Just some clarification/reminders for the first few weeks back.

### **World Book day and Reading Parents session- 3<sup>rd</sup> March**

World Book Day is Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March. If children want to, they can come dressed up as their favourite book character. If the children would rather not dress up, this isn't a problem at all, they can just come in their usual PE kit. At 2pm Parents are welcome to come into school to meet with myself and some of the staff to discuss a Love of Reading with a particular focus on our Read Write Inc scheme. At 2pm the children will still be doing their PE and music sessions but after school there is a PE club and so if you need childcare they can remain at school to take part in that. We aim for the session to finish around 3.30.

### **Masked Reader**

You may remember a while ago I gave you a 'heads up' about the masked reader activity. This is just for fun. If the children want to take part they can send in a video of themselves reading a poem or excerpt of a book whilst wearing a mask and distorting their voice. Other children, on World Book Day, will try and guess the masked reader. I have already been sent some and they are great. Your child can either wear a mask/hat/disguise and put on a silly voice or you can use an app to distort their face/voice. The easiest way to send these in to us is by Showbie. Just click the + button and upload from your computer. Otherwise you can try and email it through- it depends on the size of them.
