We will observe the national holiday scheduled for Her Majesty's funeral, which means schools are likely to be closed that day, but outside of this, school hours will continue as normal. When I know of more information I will of course inform you.

We will be holding an assembly on Tuesday when the whole school community is together. If you think your child may be experiencing particular upset due to the passing of The Queen, please do let us know so we can provide additional support if needed.

A couple of start of year reminders/notices-

- Please be mindful of where you park outside of school. Please avoid driveways, grass verges and any gateways.
- On leaving school, please can I ask that your children do not climb on the school walls. The younger children have started to copy and I am worried for their safety. We also have had damage to the wire fencing which has been pulled away from the wall.
- You may not be aware but the small entrance at the side of the school is not actually school land and it opens on to our neighbours garden. A lot of children have been going on to their land and playing in the trees there


ETHOS group

Did you know...?

Free School meals

Your child may be entitled to receive free school meals if you are entitled to receive one of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190.
- Universal Credit (Provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400)

If you think you are eligible please complete an online application at:

www.cheshirewestandchester.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals - this is the quickest and easiest way to apply. Alternatively, you may to telephone the Free School Meals helpline - 0300 123 8123.

Eligibility for Free School Meal entitlement also provides eligibility for Pupil Premium, a Government grant paid to school for the purpose of raising attainment levels and closing the gap for disadvantaged children.
